

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF THE TOWN
OF WESTON, TEXAS

TO THE HONORABLE W. G. PROCTOR, COUNTY JUDGE, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned freehold resident citizen taxpayers of Collin County and the State of Texas, and residents of the Town of Weston in the County of Collin, State of Texas, respectfully show the Court:

I.

That the inhabitants of the Town of Weston, in Collin County, Texas, desire to incorporate as a Town containing more than 200 inhabitants under the provision of Title 28 of Vernon's Civil Statutes of Texas and particularly as set forth in Article 1133 and 1134 in Chapter 1, Title 28, Vernon's Civil Statutes of Texas.

2.

That the boundaries of the said proposed incorporated town are as follows, to-wit:

See attached plat and field notes

3.

That the name of the said proposed incorporated town shall be Weston.

4.

That we, the undersigned citizens, being more than 20 in number, are each a resident of the said proposed town, residing within the limits of the boundaries above set forth, and that each of us has attained at least the age of 21 years, has resided within the limits of the proposed city for at least 6 months next preceding the filing of this petition and is a qualified elector and voter under the laws of this state.

5.

That there are more than 200 inhabitants and less than 5,000 inhabitants residing within the limits of the boundaries above set forth of the said proposed incorporated town.

6.

That a map or plat of said proposed incorporated town including therein no territory except that which is intended to be used for strictly town purposes, marked Exhibit "A", is attached hereto and made a part of this petition or application.

WHEREFORE, we, the undersigned qualified voters of the proposed incorporated town of Weston, Texas, hereby made application to, and hereby petition, this Honorable Court to forthwith make an order for the holding of an election on a day in said order named and at a place therein designated located within the territorial limits above described for the purposes of submitting to a vote of the qualified voters of said territory and proposed incorporated town the question as to whether or not said town shall be incorporated as such under the name of Weston.





Weston Votes For Incorporation, 96-6

Voters in the Weston area Saturday voted nearly unanimously to incorporate the town.

Ninety-seven votes were cast, of which 96 were in favor of incorporation, and only 6 against.

Election judge was Ray Bourland. Assisting him were Leland Mugg, Mrs. Floyd Wallen, Miss Mozelle Driver, and Herman Hayes.

Members of a 7-man committee which has promoted the incorporation proposal have notified County Judge Bill Proctor of the results of the election, and are asking that an election be called to choose city officials. The committee has consulted with officials in Dorchester, which Grayson county town has also just incorporated, in an effort to learn more about the problems which they might face.

One committee member said it was his impression that a mayor, a five-man council, and a town marshal would be elected.

The town's new boundaries will extend for several hundred feet on each side of the FM roads two or three miles from the business street of Weston.

City Election Called For Weston July 10

The newly-incorporated city of Weston will be holding an election July 10 to select a mayor and five councilmen.

The Collin County Commissioners Court called the election after Weston voters chose to incorporate their city last month.

On the ballot will be three candidates for mayor and nine for the remaining five posts of the council.

Running for mayor are Sam Dunlap, Thomas R. Kissinger, and John Tingle.

Candidates for the five council seats include Louis L. Cave, Raymond D. Heistand, Kenneth W. Hendrix, Herman Hayes, Lowell Jones, William Litchford, Delmar W. Montgomery, Mrs. Jack (Marie) Perry and Alfred J. Verzi.

Dunlap, whose mail address is Route 1, Anna, is a real estate salesman with Leonard Duckworth Realtors in Dallas. He served on the committee for incorporation of the town.

Tingle, a former Richardson builder, owns and operates two farms in the Weston area and lives on one of them. He was also a member of the incorporation committee.

Kissinger lives in the present town of Weston and plans to build a new home there soon.

He is a certified public accountant.

Councilman candidate Heistand is an industrial photographer, working for Melsel Photochrome Corporation in Dallas.

His mail address is Route 1, Celina.

Montgomery is a retired employee of the Commodity Credit Corporation in Dallas and prior to that was an employee of Sears, Roebuck Inc.

Cave, a long-time resident of the area, works for Texas Instruments and lives on Route

1, Celina.

Jones has been an employee of Groyedyke Transport Co. for a number of years. He lives in Weston.

Verzi is the regional manager of Lipton's Pet Foods in Dallas. His address is Route 4, McKinney.

Mrs. Perry is a long-time resident of Weston and is employed by Texas Instruments.

Hendrix is an employee of Texas Instruments also.

Litchford is a resident of the Weston Community and is operating a farm there.

of Weston, Texas, all of whom have been satisfactorily shown
to the Court to have attained at least the age of 21 years
of age, to be qualified voters and electors of this State,
and to have been residents of the territory hereinafter
described for at least 6 months next preceding the filing
of this application, to incorporate the Town of Weston,
Texas, and stating the boundaries of the proposed incor-
porated town to be known as Weston as follows, to-wit:

COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS

BEGINNING at a stake which bears South 500 ft. and West 500 ft. from the center line of the intersection of F.M. Hwy #455 and F.M. Hwy #543.

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Satisfactory proof having been made to the Court that the said territory hereinbefore described as the Town of Weston, Collin County, Texas, contains in excess of 200 inhabitants and less than 5,000 inhabitants as required by Articles 1133 and 1134 of Vernon's Civil Statutes of Texas and the Court finding that in excess of 200 inhabitants and less than 5,000 inhabitants reside within the limits of the hereinbefore described territory, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THIS COURT that an election be held between the hours of 8:00 A.M., and 7:00 P. M., on the 15 day of May, A. D., 1971, at Weston Community Center, located in Weston, Texas, such place being located within the hereinbefore described area, for the purpose of submitting the question of the incorporation of the Town of Weston, Collin County, Texas, to the vote of those inhabitants who have attained at least the age of 21 years, have resided within the territorial limits of said proposed town for a period of 6 months next preceding this date and who are qualified voters and electors under the laws of this state.

It is further ordered by the Court that the voters at the above called election write or cause to be written or printed on his or her ballot or ticket "Corporation" or "No Corporation."

It is further ordered by the Court that if a majority of the votes are cast in favor of the corporation, the officer hereinafter designated to preside at the election shall make return thereof to this Court within ten days after the election is held.

It is further ordered by the Court that _____
Roy Bourland, a qualified voter of the said proposed incorporated town, be, and he is hereby appointed as officer to preside at the election and he is ordered to select two judges and two clerks to assist in holding such election.

It is further and finally ordered by the Court that said officer post a certified copy of this order on or before the 20 day of April, A. D., 1971, in three public places which are located within the territorial limits of said proposed incorporated town.
