

ORDINANCE NO. 98-09-02

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF WESTON, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1998-1999; PROVIDING FOR APPORTIONING THE LEVY FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Weston has adopted a budget in accordance with Chapter 102 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the Weston City Council finds that it is necessary for good government to levy an initial ad valorem tax for the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. There is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government of the City of Weston, Collin County, Texas, for the fiscal year of 1998-1999, upon all property, real, personal, and mixed, within the corporate limits of said City subject to taxation, a tax of \$0. 150 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property.

Section 2. All monies collected under this Ordinance for the specific items as set out in the budget heretofore adopted by the City, and the same are hereby appropriated and set apart for the specific purpose indicated in the budget and that the Tax Collector and City Secretary as the case may be, shall keep these accounts so as to readily and distinctly show the amount collected, the amounts expended, and the amount on hand at any time, belonging to such funds. It is hereby made the duty of the Tax Collector and every person collecting money for the City of Weston to deliver to the City Secretary any tax monies received, and a statement of the source of such tax revenue. All tax receipts for the City are hereby made payable to the General Fund of the City.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after October 1, 1998.
