

ORDINANCE NO. 99-09-02

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS, FOR THE 1999-2000 FISCAL YEAR: PROVIDING FOR APPORTIONING EACH LEVY FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES: AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS.

SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government of the City of Weston upon all real property within the corporate limits of said City subject to taxation, a tax of \$ 0.15 on each \$100.00 valuation of property, said tax being levied and apportioned for the maintenance and support of the general government.

SECTION 2. That taxes levied under this Ordinance shall be due October 1, 1999 and if not paid on or before February 1, 2000 shall immediately become delinquent. Taxpayers who have qualified for the over 65 years age exemption on their homestead may pay their taxes in four (4) equal installments due January 31, March 31, May 31 and July 31, 2000 without penalty or interest accruing.

SECTION 3. All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed, and the assessor and collector of the City of Weston is hereby authorized and empowered to enforce the collection of such taxes according to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and ordinances of the City of Weston shall, by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property for the payment of such taxes, penalty and interest, and, the interest and penalty collected from such delinquent taxes shall be apportioned to the general fund of the City of Weston. All delinquent taxes shall bear interest from the date of delinquency at the rate as prescribed by state law.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective on the date of its adoption.

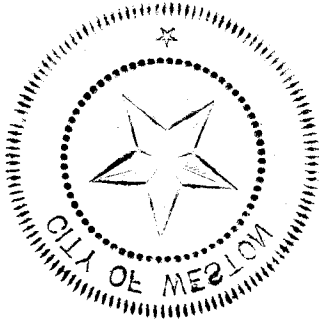
